From NASA JPL, who will speak on the successful Mars landing.

Adam Steltzner is a renowned engineer with NASA Jet Propulsion Laboratory who led the team responsible for the Curiosity rover’s successful landing on Mars. He is also the author of the book “The Right Kind of Crazy: A True Story of Teamwork, Leadership and High-Stakes Innovation.” Over his career he has been involved with a number of projects, including Galileo, which studied Jupiter and its moons, Cassini for a Saturn mission and several Mars-related projects like Pathfinder, Spirit and Opportunity.
